



Technology Coordinator Quick Reference Card

Use this checklist and linked resources to prepare and support your school's administration of the DC CAPE Assessments. More information can be found on the <u>DC Pearson Support Site</u>.

- Ensure each testing device meets technology requirements (see <u>System Requirements):</u>
 - Ensure the infrastructure (e.g., wireless access points, bandwidth) is adequate
 - Remove (or turn off) any software that would allow secure test material on testing devices to be viewed on another testing device during testing
 - Manage any problems with firewalls
- Install and Set Up TestNav
 - o Install TestNav8 on all student test devices
 - On each device, launch TestNav and select District of Columbia so students will bypass this screen (it only appears on first access per device)

- Run 'App Check' in TestNav. This is accessed from the user drop-down menu:
 - Basic tests can be completed in around 10 seconds

 - o Know where to check status of TestNav and ADAM on the <u>Status Hub</u>
- Tasks that no longer apply for Spring 2024 administration:
